

## **1934 GAR Representative Badge - Chief Munsey**

**This is a pin, medallion and ribbon from the 55th Annual Encampment of the GAR in 1934. The pin and medallion are made of a very heavy bronze-colored metal. The pin has "Representative GAR" and "When Can Their Glory Fade" along with a star, wreath and flag design. The attached medallion has the portrait of an Indian, with "Chief Munsey" around his head. The ribbon has worn through and come apart at the bottom (can be seen in photos). The prior owner has reattached it with scotch tape. The ribbon is red, white and blue and has the following printed in gold lettering: "55th Annual Encampment Department Indiana Muncie 1934". The manufacturer's paper tag is still attached on the reverse. Aside from the tape and split, the ribbon has some fraying to its end. The metal portions of the badge are in excellent condition.
